


Model Angela Caloisi Wears Rami Kadi Couture at the Premiere of Father Mother Sister Brother during the 82nd Venice International Film Festival.

Her look combined strength and elegance, adding a bold couture statement to the Venice red carpet while reflecting the Maison's artistry and commitment to innovation.









Model Maria Borges Wears Rami Kadi Couture at the Premiere of The Smashing Machine during the 82nd Venice International Film Festival.

Her look reflected Rami Kadi's mastery of merging structure with artistry, bringing a modern couture edge to the cinematic celebration.






